Today's gospel is from John, the 6th chapter.

¹ Some time later, Jesus crossed over to the other side of the Sea of Galilee—that is, Lake Tiberius—² and a huge crowd followed him, impressed by the signs he gave by healing sick people. ³ Jesus climbed the hillside and sat down there with the disciples. ⁴ It was shortly before the Jewish feast of Passover. ⁵ Looking up, Jesus saw the crowd approaching and said to Philip, "Where can we buy some bread for these people to eat?" ⁶ Jesus knew very well what he was going to do, but asked this to test Philip's response. ⁷ Philip answered, "Not even with two hundred days' wages could we buy loaves enough to give each of them a mouthful!" ⁸ One of the disciples, Simon Peter's brother Andrew, said, "There's a small boy here with five barley loaves and two dried fish. But what good is that for so many people?" ¹⁰ Jesus said to them, "Make the people sit down." There was plenty of grass there, and as many as five thousand families sat down. ¹¹ Then Jesus took the loaves, gave thanks, and gave them out to all who were sitting there; he did the same with the fish, giving out as much as they could eat. ¹² When the people had eaten their fill, Jesus said to the disciples, "Gather up the leftover pieces so that nothing gets wasted." ¹³ So they picked them up and filled twelve baskets with the scraps left over from the five barley loaves. ¹⁴ The people, seeing this sign that Jesus had performed, said, "Surely this is the Prophet who was to come into the world." ¹⁵ Seeing that they were about to come and carry him off to crown him as ruler, Jesus escaped into the hills alone.
